



About the Program

The one-day Teaching on the Run (TOTR) program for junior medical officers (JMOs) is a professional development package that incorporates three modules:
Module 1-Clinical Teaching; Module 2-Skills Teaching; Module 3-Assessment Fundamentals

In 2019, an additional three modules will be offered (May program) for JMOs who have previously completed the initial three modules.

Module 4-Planning Learning; Module 5-Effective Group Teaching; Module 6-Supporting Learners)

Format

The program is delivered in 'blended format' meaning that part of the program material must be completed online. This reduces the time required for the face-to-face component of the program.

- The program is open to junior doctors (PGY1-4) from all Australian states and territories.

- A certificate of attendance will be provided to participants who attend all components of the program.
